The FamilyEducational Rights and Privacyct (FERPA) affords parents and students who are 18 years of age or olde ("eligible students") certain rights with specto the student beducation records. These rights e:

[Optional] Upon request, the school disclosed scation records it hout consent o officials of another school disct in which a student seeks or intends o enroll, or is already enrolled if the disclosures for purposes of the student's enrollment mansfer. [NOTE: FERPA requires a school district o make a reasonable attempt notify the parent or student of the ecords request unless it states in its annual notification that it intends to forward records on request.]
