ProposedEmergency Measure to Amend Sections 86.1, 86.2, 86.3, and 86.4 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education Relating to the Albert Shanker National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Certification Grant Program. Murphy, Deputy Commissioner for Higher Education, and Elena Bruno, Professional Standards and Practices Board Secretary and Albert Shanker Grant Coordinator, presented proposed amendments related to the Albert Shanker Grante amendments would revise the eligibility requirements for teachers for grant funds to cover costs associated with obtaining and maintaining National Board Certification.

The Albert Shanker Grant currendly provides grant funds to teachers to defray the initial cost of obtaining National Board Certification. Nationally Board Certified Teachers (NBCT) energy their certification at their own expense. The proposed amendments would make funding available to be the initial cost of obtaining to renew their National Board Certification at the five ar expiration date as required by the National Board's Maintenance of Certification process.
