DASA Training. The Board of Regents permanently <u>adopted the regulatory amendment</u> that removes the threeclock hour, face-to-face instruction requirement for the Dignity for All Students (DASA) training, allowing the training to be provided entirely online.

NEW YORK STATE TEACHER CERTIFICATION EXAMINATIONS (NYSTCE) TEST DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

Draft Computer Science Content Specialty Test (CST) Framework. The draft framework for the new Computer Science CST is available on the <u>NYSTCE website</u> to assist candidates and computer science education programs in the preparation of candidates for the assessment. It is anticipated that the final framework will be posted in Summer 2022 and the Computer Science CST will be operational in 2023.

NEW RESOURCES TO SUPPORT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NYS P-12 SCIENCE LEARNING STANDARDS

The Office of Curriculum and Instruction has released new professional development resources on their science website to support the work of educators, administrators, and science stakeholders as they work towards implementation of the New York State P-12 Science Learning Standards. Resources include turnkey professional development guides with sample presentations and a "Quick Guide" to the new Standards. RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR APPROVED CTLE SPONSORS IN TEACH

Continuing teacher and leader education (CTLE) sponsors are approved for a five-year term, which may be renewed. New York State institutions of higher education with registered educator preparation programs will complete an electronic CTLE Sponsor attestation through the <u>TEACH system</u> for the renewal, similar to the first application process.
