The <u>first amendment</u> allows schools and BOCES to utilize computer science courses to meet career and technical education(CTE) requirements anglermits teachers holding a valid Computer Science certificate to obtain the extension in Coordinator of WeBased Learning Programs for Career Development he <u>second amendment</u> extends the implementation timeline for the <u>computer science statement</u> of <u>continued eligibility</u>(SOCE) by one year. As a result, teachers of computer science courses would not need to hold the ComputeScience certificate or SOCE until September 1, 2024.
