Subject: Parent/Guardian Notifications Regarding Student Illness or Injury

To assist schools in keeping students healthy and safe, this memorandum provides information regarding the requirement to provide timely information to parent/guardians concerning student illness and/or injury to enable the parent/guardian to obtain appropriate care for their child.

It is essential that parents/guardians are kept informed of illnesses or injuries that occur in schece **Be**44pre language. This is

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to the child...of the individual child's health condition; to instruct the school personnel in procedures to take in case of accident or illness." In New York City, health services are governed by <u>Chancellor's Regulations A-701 School Health Services (nyc.gov)</u>, which requires the principal notify the parent/guardian of accidents or illness if the condition warrants more emergency care than can be given at school. Non-public schools are strongly encouraged to adopt similar policies in their schools to insure the health and safety of their students.
